Show Rules

1. All entry forms (with entrance fees 30p per entry to Helen Phillips, 26 Ferrands Park Way, Harden BD16 1HZ by Thursday 7th September 2023. (ANY EXHIBIT MAY BE REMOVED BY THE EXHIBITOR BETWEEN 4.00PM AND 4.15PM). All exhibits remaining after that time will be auctioned for charity (sections J,K excepted). The society greatly appreciates the generosity of exhibitors, which enables it to carry on the work for the village.
2. Judging of all Dahlia classes will be under National Dahlia Society rules, and in all Chrysanthemum classes under National Chrysanthemum Society rules. Entries in all these classes must be named varieties.
3. All entries must be staged by 10.30am on the show day, at which time the show tent will be cleared of all persons except Judges and Show Officials. Show tent will open from 2.00pm to 6pm on Saturday 9th September and 8.00am to 10.30am on the show day to stage your items. Entries MUST be clearly marked with your exhibitor number fastened to them.
4. Cabbages, Parsnips, Turnips, Swedes, Beetroot and Bakery exhibits may be cut by the judges if desired.
5. Entries to section D&E. Kitchen Garden, points will not be included in overall points.
6. Entries in classes J240-J266 inclusive, K284-K302 inclusive MUST be made during the 12 MONTHS PRIOR TO THIS SHOW
7. Points and prize money:
 - a) Points awarded to all classes will be: 1st: 3 points 2nd: 2 points 3rd: 1 point awarded.
 - b) All prize monies are as specified in class headings
8. PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID FROM 4.00PM.
9. The number of entries by any one exhibitor in any class is unrestricted. There is no restriction on the number of prizes that can be won by any one exhibitor in each class.
10. The judges have power to withhold prizes if, in their opinion, exhibits are not worthy of a prize. The decision of the Judges will be FINAL.
11. The beer and wine classes will be judged by the Chairman.
12. All reasonable care of exhibits will be taken during the show but the committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
13. All trophies remain the property of the Society and are held by the winners for one year. Trophies to be returned to Christine Robinson, 28 Millbeck Drive, Harden, no later than 31st August.
14. The committee will strictly enforce all rules.
15. The committee will decide all matters of dispute not covered by these rules. Any objection must be made to the Secretary before 3pm on the show day accompanied by a deposit of £1, this will be returned if the objection is upheld. Trophies will be presented by the Chairman of the Society at 4.00pm.
